Delegate Terms and Conditions



Please Note: COVID Vaccination Requirements

All delegates and attendees must abide by the current NSW Government health orders, regulations, and advice at the time of the event.

Delegate Cancellations:

Cancellation requests must be received in writing by email to SoilCare Inc. We understand that emergencies arise, and we will make every effort to accommodate delegate needs.

- If an in-person delegate registration cancellation request is received on or before 1 November 2022, you have the following options:
 1. Convert your in-person registration for a virtual registration for yourself and one colleague.
 2. Convert to virtual registration and the difference will be refunded.
 3. Full refund, minus an administration fee AUD\$15.00.
- If an in-person delegate registration cancellation request is received after 1 November 2022 you have the following options:
 1. Your delegate status will convert to a virtual delegate for yourself and one colleague.
 2. Your in-person delegate registration can be transferred to a colleague upon written application to SoilCare Inc.

Note: Virtual Conference sessions can be accessed on-line for 1 year after the event.

- If you are unable to attend the conference due to government restrictions, but the event is still proceeding, you will have the following options:
 1. Convert your in-person registration for a virtual registration for yourself and one colleague.
 2. Your in-person delegate registration can be transferred to a colleague upon written application to SoilCare Inc.

Substitutions:

- Delegate substitutions are permitted with prior written agreement of SoilCare.
- Delegates are not allowed to share a registration – one registration per delegate.

Alterations to the program, cancellation, or postponement of the conference/event.

- SoilCare Inc reserves the right to make alterations to the arrangements of conference/event as published, either before or during the conference/event.
- In the unlikely event of the conference/event being cancelled by SoilCare, a full refund will be made. Liability will be limited to the registration fee paid by the delegate.
- In the event of it being found necessary, for whatever reason, that the conference/event be postponed, the dates or the venue be changed, SoilCare Inc shall not be liable for expenditure, damage or loss incurred by the delegate.
- In the event of it being found necessary, for whatever reason, that the conference/event be postponed a second time, SoilCare reserves the option to convert the conference to a virtual event. SoilCare shall not be liable for expenditure, damage or loss incurred by the delegate.

Insurance:
